Our event spaces are available to rent to organizations and initiatives for conferences, seminars, corporate events, and much more. All profits from our event operations support the work of the One World Center.

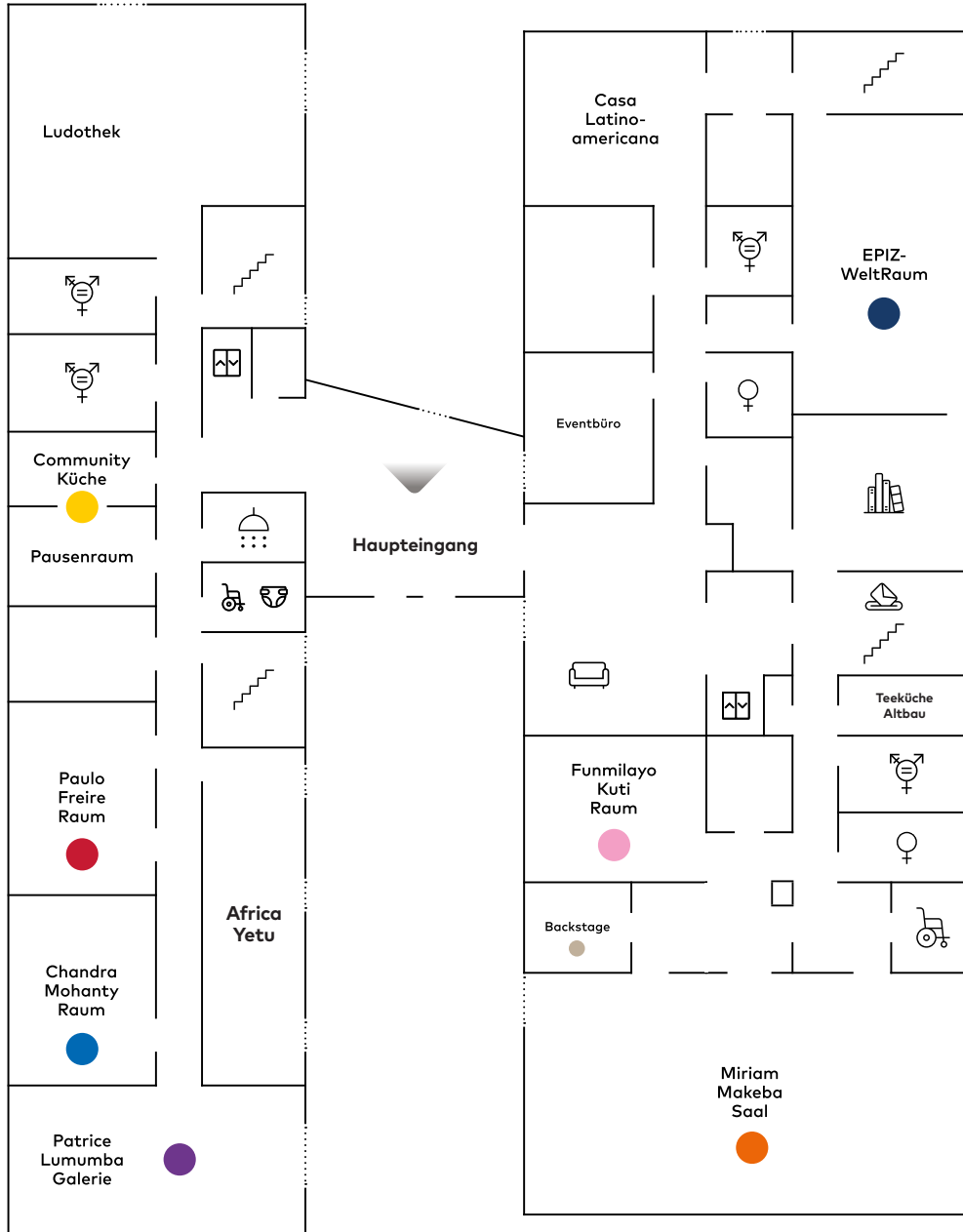

Miriam Makeba Hall

Capacity: 140 row Seating | 180 standing

Size: 165 m²

DESCRIPTION:

With customizable stage setup possible, the Hall can be divided into three rooms with mobile partitions if needed, the ventilation system features with cooling and heating functions. It is located towards the Kindl-Site with its own entrance.

Reception or gathering area next to the foyer/main entrance.

The walls can be used as exhibition space and the room is suitable for setting up catering, standing receptions, coat checks or formats.

A passage room for the house staff, therefore this space is not 100% exclusive.

Prep kitchen for catering, drinks and snacks.

5. FAQ – General information

CLEANING FEES

We charge a cleaning fee of 45€ per seminar room/booking. For the community kitchen and the community café, we charge 80€ each. For the Miriam Makeba Hall, a cleaning fee of 200€ is due per booking.

We kindly ask you to leave the event rooms tidy and in the standard setup:

- Put used dishes into the dishwasher in the tea kitchen
- Collect rubbish and dispose of it in the appropriate bins
- Sweep up coarse dirt.

If the rooms are left excessively dirty or untidy, we reserve the right to charge additional cleaning costs.

USAGE TIMES

Time for set-up and breakdown times must be included in the booking period. Access fobs are activated only for the booking period.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

Catering

We do not offer catering services or beverages, however, you are welcome to hire a catering service of your choice. We can recommend various catering companies upon request.

Self-catering

Tea kitchens are available for self-catering. Dishware for coffee and tea with cups and glasses for 16 people are included in the room rental for the smaller seminar rooms. The hall includes around 150 cups and approx. 50 glasses. Organizers must return clean, washed dishes.

ROOM ACCESS

Access Fobs

We use a fob system for access to the building and seminar rooms. These are programmed and activated for the booking period. Fobs are available for pick up either before the event by arrangement or on the event day.

Access

The guidance system at Berlin Global Village uses names and color coding for the rooms. For easier navigation, we recommend informing participants of their event room in advance.

KINDL SITE / CAMPUS

Our One World Center is located on the former grounds of the Berliner Kindl Brewery in Berlin Neukölln at Rollberg. Our neighbors on the site include:

ACCESSIBILITY

Our public areas are accessible without steps on the ground floor. Both areas have accessible toilets. Parking spaces for people with physical disabilities are available in front of the center. Additional measures for barrier-free use of our spaces are in planning.

TOILET FACILITIES

Our toilet facilities are generally gender-neutral. In addition, we offer two toilet rooms specifically for women*. Free menstrual products such as pads and tampons are available in the ground floor restrooms. The Altbau and Neubau each have one barrier-free toilet room with changing table and diaper bin on the ground floor.

GETTING HERE

Public Transportation

Berlin Global Village is easily accessible by public transport: U7 Rathaus Neukölln, U8 Boddinstraße, and bus lines M43 and 166 at Morusstraße stop 32

Parking

Berlin Global Village has no dedicated parking spaces. The nearest parking is available at PARK ONE garage in Rollbergstraße. Parking spaces for people with disabilities are available in front of the building

Deliveries

Delivery vehicles may stop for loading/unloading in front of the entrance stairs. Long-term parking is not permitted.

DECOLONIAL MONUMENT

Between the two buildings in the outdoor area of Berlin Global Village, Berlin's first memorial to decolonization has stood since 2024. The Decolonial memorial EarthNest by the artist collective The Lockward Collective resembles an open bronze nest. It invites reflection on our colonial past, its impacts, and decolonial resistance. The memorial is not just artwork but a space for dialogue, encounter, and healing. Since November 15, 2024, it has been publicly accessible in front of Berlin Global Village.

- Tea kitchens: cabinet fronts made from leftover wood
